IHCC COLLEGE STUDY PROGRAM

The following represents the specific terms of this contract of educational services between Indian Hills Community College (IHCC) and the Fairfield Area Career Academy Consortium.

1. IHCC will offer the mutually agreed upon course(s) as listed in Exhibit B, during the school years.
2. The District will ensure that each student will have completed and submitted a College Study Program Application/Enrollment Form no later than the first Monday of September preceding the school-year of enrollment.
3. Each student will register for their IHCC classes on the same schedule and under the same guidelines established for all new and/or returning IHCC students. High school students will be subject to all IHCC policies and procedures as published in the IHCC catalog.
4. The school year will run according to IHCC calendar with exception to agreed upon modifications.
5. The IHCC Registrar will certify grades and credits and send them to the District within thirty (30) calendar days after the end of the IHCC academic term in which final grades are issued.
6. IHCC agrees to provide: curricular materials, books, instructors, equipment

FCSD Career Academy Student Eligibility Requirements

All high school students selected for enrollment in IHCC College Study Program must be approved by their District and IHCC, and meet the following eligibility requirements:

1. Be considered in good standing by the district and IHCC.
2. Have completed online registration with IHCC/FCSD personnel. College Study Program Application/Enrollment Form from their parents and their district.
3. All students in class must be enrolled for college credit.
4. For Non-CTE courses, students must demonstrate proficiency, using Iowa Assessments test scores, in math, reading, and/or science or deemed proficient through the district's alternative assessment process as outlined in FCSD Board Policy #604.4. This pertains to PSE, CE, or FACA courses.

****All requests for withdrawal may be faxed to High School Programs, 641-683-5118. Verification of approval will be granted within 2 days. If the District does not receive verification, it is their responsibility to contact the IHCC for confirmation. Any students withdrawing from classes through the tenth (10th) week of the term will receive a “W” (withdrawal) on their transcripts. Failure to complete the add-drop/withdrawal process properly may result in the student receiving an F (failing) on their transcripts. FHS students will follow the FHS drop policies as well.**

ADDING COURSES: All requests to add a course(s) must be received by IHCC prior to the first instructional day of the term. All requests must include a College Study Program Application/Enrollment form.
